Impact additional security regulations for cargo to the USA - update

Air France-KLM-Martinair Cargo commits to minimise impact on quality

Dear customer,

As shared with you earlier today, the US Transportation Security Administration (TSA) has recently implemented a new amendment to the security regulations for cargo traffic into or transiting the USA, requiring temporary additional security screening from selected origins.

We have implemented several operational solutions that enable us to execute the screening within the timeframe to respect your booking. Therefore the impact on the quality of your shipments on board of Air France, KLM and Martinair operated flights to the USA is expected to be minimal.

As from this moment also 057 and 074 AWB shipments on Delta operated flights are included in above mentioned solutions.
