EU restrictive measures for Russia

Dear customer,

As a result of the developments in Eastern Ukraine, the EU Council's Committee of Permanent Representatives reached an agreement on restrictive measures towards Russia (see attachment).

Based on these measures, following procedure will be applicable until further notice for all shipments to Russia on KLM or Martinair operated flights:

- With immediate effect, a signed declaration upon delivery of your shipment is required. Please find this declaration form attached. This declaration form is also available on the Air France-KLM-Martinair Cargo website (landing page "**Declaration of compliance**").
- As from Thursday, August 14th 12:00 CET , consolidations to Russia on KLM and Martinair operated flights will **not** be accepted anymore.

Depending on guidelines from local customs authorities on how to proceed with the sanctions opposed by the EU, a possible change of procedures can be expected.
