Introducing our summer 2017 Cargo network

Air France KLM Martinair Cargo will start operating its new summer schedule on Sunday, 26 March. With a fleet of 170 long-haul passenger aircraft and six full freighters, we are able to offer vast capacity on around 1,125 weekly services to 127 destinations across our global network.

We have once more extended our wide-body belly network, as we did last winter, and are proud to announce the start of operations to five NEW destinations:

- From *Paris Charles de Gaulle (CDG)* we offer our customers a thrice weekly service to **Accra (ACC) – Ghana** using Boeing 777-200 equipment (this service commenced on 28 February).
- From *Amsterdam Airport Schiphol (AMS)* we are opening new routes to **Freetown (FNA) – Sierra Leone** and **Monrovia (ROB) – Liberia**, both thrice weekly using Airbus A330 equipment, to **Cartagena (CTG) – Colombia**, also thrice weekly, using Boeing 787 Dreamliner equipment and to **Minneapolis (MSP) - USA**, thrice weekly on an Airbus A330.

In addition to our wide-body belly capacity, we will continue to offer main-deck capacity (123 frequencies/week to 41 destinations), using Boeing 747-combi and freighter aircraft out of Amsterdam, and Boeing 777 freighter services out of Paris Charles de Gaulle. We will continue to mainly deploy our cargo aircraft on routes between Europe and Latin America and to/from Africa, to serve ongoing strong demand (e.g. from the fresh flower industry) for this type of transport.

For express cargo, Air France Cargo launched a brand new automated hub at CDG, combining proximity to the aircraft parking positions and a sorting capability of 6,000 parcels an hour. A brand new sorter is also due to open at AMS in the course of 2017.

In 2016, AFKLMP cargo also opened a brand new warehouse at New York JFK airport with the capacity to handle all types of cargo, from general to verticals. The facility is located next door to The Ark at JFK, a new terminal entirely dedicated to live animal logistics.

In 2017, AFKLMP Cargo intends to strengthen and expand its digital footprint with a wide range of innovative solutions. Using myCargo, customers will benefit from an innovative online dashboard customised to their specific needs. This goes hand-in-hand with systems allowing online quotes and bookings, multilingual websites and other developments designed to ease the journey for our customers.
